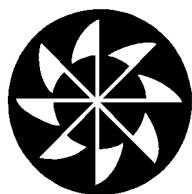

## LEGISLATION FINAL, 2005

Thursday, February 17, was the deadline for bills to be introduced to the 47th Legislature, now in session until March 19 when final versions of all legislation must be determined and sent to the Governor for his signature or veto. For bills that have been introduced and could affect libraries in New Mexico, see those listed below, and earlier listings in *Hitchhiker* issues #1582 and #1585.
